What Information Is Collected By Splash?

We collect personal information when you voluntarily submit it to us, such as name, address, email address, telephone numbers and/or credit/debit card information.

How We Use Donor Information

The donor information we collect is used for internal purposes only, such as to:

- Process donations
- Respond to inquiries
- Issue receipts for donations
- Acknowledge and thank donors for their gifts
- Inform supporters about current and upcoming activities and events
- Comply with current rules and regulations governing IRS 501(c)(3) financial reporting

How We Protect Your Information

Personally identifiable information (PII) is saved in our secure database and is not publicly accessible. PII is only accessible by specific Splash employees based on regulated permissions. To avoid unauthorized access, Splash follows electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. Furthermore, we use a secure donation processing service. Every credit card transactions is processed using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) encryption, to provide an additional level of security.

We will not disclose your PII to third parties, except to parties who perform services for us such as sending you e-mail, web hosting, credit card processing, and other similar services, or if required to do so by law. Splash does not sell or share your personal information to third parties for financial gain.
